Palo Alto College offers Wintermester three-week online courses

Alamo Colleges District–Palo Alto College will offer Wintermester for the second year in a row, which will provide 15 courses over a three-week holiday break. The registration deadline is Friday, Dec. 14.

Wintermester courses are online only; classes begin on Monday, Dec. 17, 2018, immediately after the Fall semester, and end on Tuesday, Jan. 8, 2019. Courses offered include:
